Personal injury whilst moving and handling the SAM2	Council employees and volunteers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All volunteers to receive guidance in safe moving and handling of equipment
Injury caused by SAM2 falling from secured position	Council employees and volunteers General public	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brackets checked by two people at time of installation • Brackets checked each time the battery is changed
