

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4742) affecting the Station Road from its junction with Fairfield Lane for 20m westwards in the PARISH OF WATLINGTON to facilitate Anglian Water new connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 29th April to 1st May 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Station Road, School Road, Downham Road, Watlington Road, Holme Road, The Causeway, West Head Road, Low Road, Stow Road, Church Road, John Davis Way (Runcton Holme Wiggshall St. Mary Magdalen, Watlington, Stow Bardolph).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
