

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4901) affecting the A10 Eastern Bypass from its junction with A1122 Southern Bypass to its junction with Bexwell Road in the TOWN OF DOWNHAM MARKET to facilitate NCC surface dressing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 19:00 and 06:00 from 3rd May to 19th June 2024 for the duration of the works only whilst signs indicating closures are in place.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

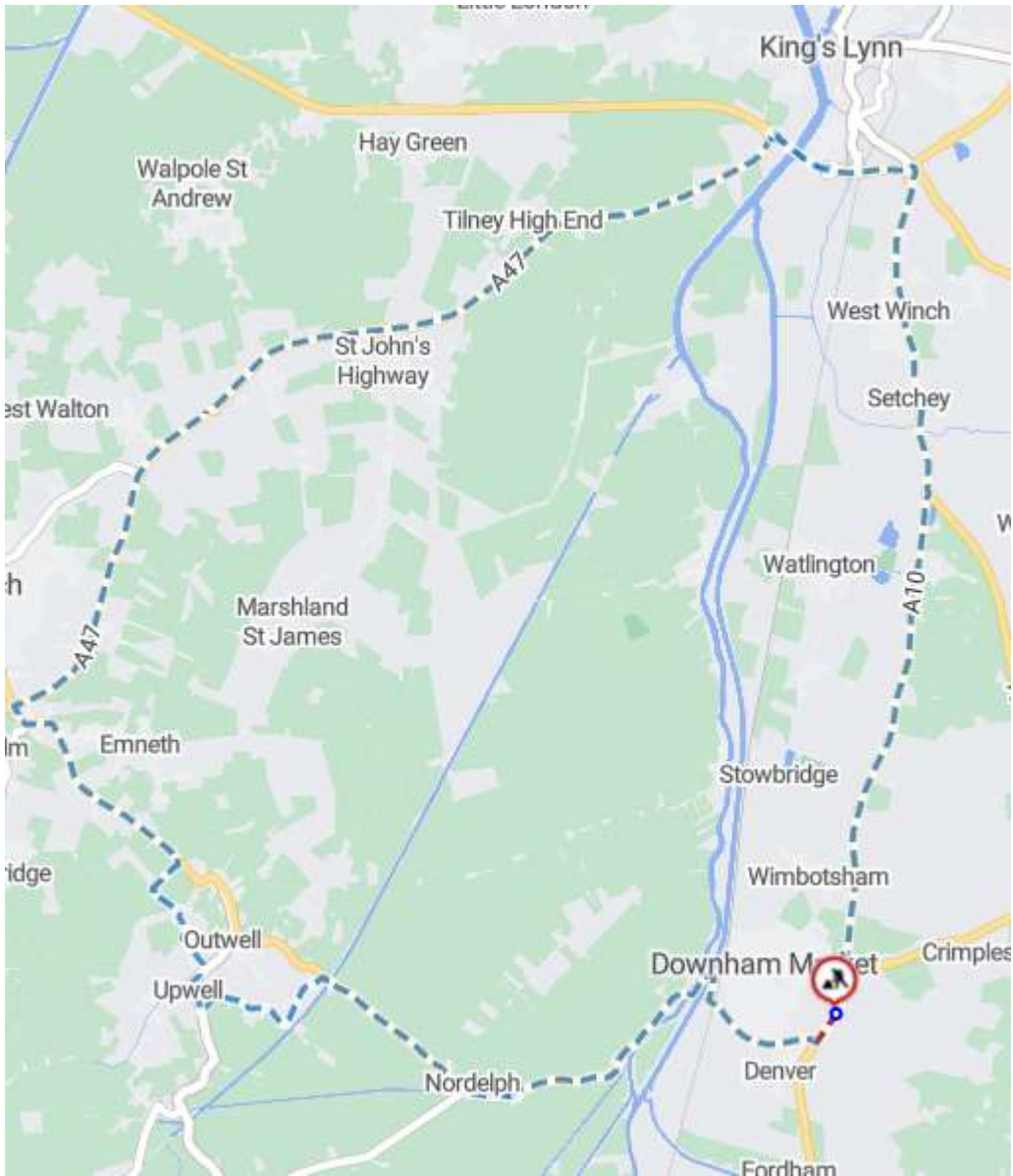
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
