

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (WTRO5310) affecting the Stow Bardolph Footpath 19 from its junction with Outwell Road (Mortons Bridge) for 535m southwards (the "Footpath") in the Parish of Stow Bardolph to facilitate silt removal from river. The Footpath will be temporarily closed/restricted for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 19th October 2024 to 31st March 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 18th April 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: N.A.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 18th April 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Footpath in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

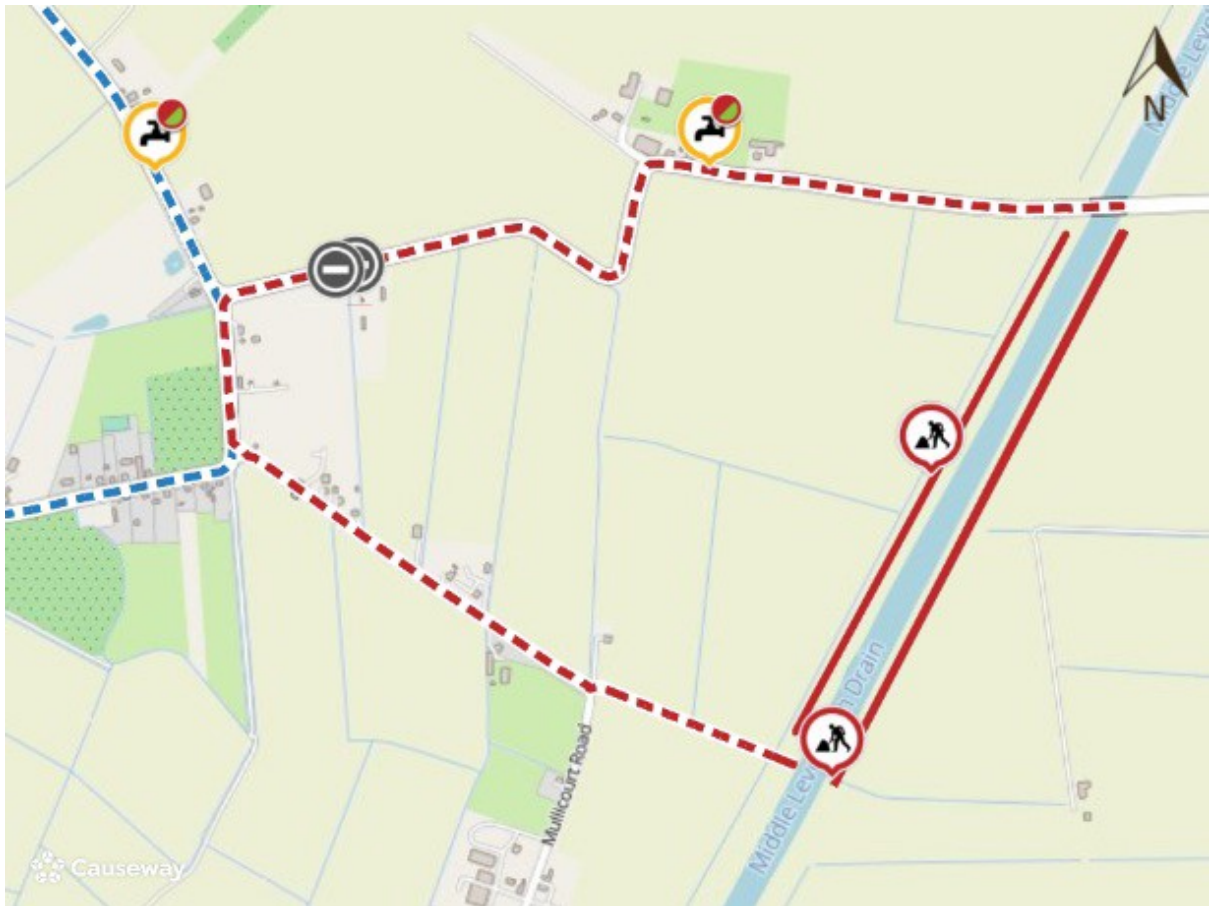
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
