

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting The Causeway crossing for 20m either side of the rail crossing in the PARISH OF STOW BARDOLPH because of Network Rail tamping lines.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 01:00 to 04:00 on 7th June 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: The Causeway, West Head Road, Low Road, Stow Road, Church Road, Station Road, School Road, Downham Road, Watlington Road, Holme Road (Runcton Holme, Wiggshall St. Mary Magdalen, Watlington, Stow Bardolph)

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
